Special Instructions for Hazardous Waste under 40 CFR Part 262 Subpart H

This waste will be subject to all applicable federal and state laws and regulations.

Please be advised of the following special RCRA requirements for import shipments of hazardous waste, including those hazardous wastes managed under the alternate management standards of 40 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Part 266 or 40 CFR Part 273 (or state equivalents). These import requirements are largely found at Title 40 CFR Part 262, Subpart H - Transboundary Movements of Hazardous Waste for Recovery or Disposal, Section 262.84 - Imports of Hazardous Waste.

For U.S. Importers:

1. U.S. importers of RCRA manifested hazardous waste are responsible for complying with all generator requirements in 40 CFR Part 262 Subparts A - D, except those related to actual accumulation on-site (§262.34), since hazardous waste import shipments are already in transit when they enter the country. U.S. importers of hazardous wastes managed under the alternate management standards of 40 CFR Part 266 or 40 CFR Part 273 are responsible for the generator requirements that are required as part of the alternate management standards.
2. Import shipments must comply with the terms of EPA's consent. Prior to making any change to the import shipments, EPA must receive and consent to a notice proposing the desired changes. To the extent that you submitted the original notice under §262.84(b)(3), you must renotify EPA. Renotifications must be submitted electronically using EPA's RCRAInfo Waste Import Export Tracking System (RCRAInfo WIETS). Any shipment using the requested changes cannot take place until the countries of transit and EPA consent to the changes and you receive an EPA AOC letter documenting the consents to the changes.
3. A U.S. hazardous waste manifest ("RCRA manifest") must accompany each shipment of hazardous waste, unless it is otherwise exempted from manifest requirements (e.g., spent lead acid batteries and universal waste are not federally required to be RCRA manifested), while the shipment is within the United States. The RCRA manifest for each shipment must identify the shipment as an import and list the point of entry into the United States in Item 16.
4. Per contracts or equivalent arrangements, you must require that an international movement document accompanies each shipment from the initiation of the shipment in the country of export until it reaches the U.S. receiving facility (§262.84(d), §161.84(f)(3)).
5. If a large quantity generator, you must file a biennial report with your authorized State Agency or regional EPA office (if the State Agency is not authorized to implement the BR program) by March 1 of each even numbered year to report hazardous wastes generated during the previous calendar year, including those from a foreign source (§262.41). Reporting on generated hazardous wastes is done using the "waste generation and management (GM)" form, as appropriate.
 - a. When calculating the total quantity of hazardous waste generated in a month, importers should add the quantity of hazardous waste imported during the calendar month to any hazardous waste generated at the importer's physical site during that calendar month. Under the RCRA regulations the date an import of hazardous waste enters the country is considered the date the waste is "generated". All hazardous waste import shipments listing the importer's EPA ID number as part of the total monthly quantity, regardless of the port of entry or border crossing used.
 - b. If you are both the importer and the receiving facility, an EPA-acceptable alternative for you to meet your generator biennial reporting requirement for those import shipments would be for you to add a statement to the comment field of your WR form for those import shipments noting that your facility was the importer of record for the listed import shipment(s). Please check with your authorized State Agency on how best to meet your generator biennial reporting requirements. Please also read the instruction section for U.S. Receiving Facilities below.
6. You must comply with the recordkeeping requirements of hazardous waste generators and maintain the following records for at least three years (§262.40 and §161.84(h)(1)):
 - a. A copy of each notification you send to EPA;
 - b. A copy of each RCRA manifest and any biennial reports;
 - c. A copy of each RCRA Acknowledgement of Consent; and
 - d. A copy of each contract.
7. You may satisfy the recordkeeping requirements by retaining electronically submitted documents in your respective accounts on EPA's RCRAInfo WIETS or EPA's e-Manifest system, provided that copies are readily available for viewing and production if requested by any EPA or authorized state inspector.

For U.S. Receiving Facilities:

1. If the import shipment is required to be accompanied by a RCRA manifest, you must add waste consent numbers (see below) matched to each hazardous waste listed in Block 9b of the RCRA manifest for the import shipment before submitting the RCRA manifest within 30 days of receiving the import shipment to EPA's e-Manifest system using one of the acceptable methods listed at <https://www.epa.gov/manifest/how-submit-hazardous-waste-manifest>. (40 CFR 264.71(a)(3)/265.71(a)(3)).

2. You must send a copy of the signed international movement document to confirm receipt within three working days of shipment delivery to the foreign exporter, and to the competent authorities of the countries of export and transit. You must additionally send a copy electronically to EPA using EPA's RCRAInfo WIETS for shipments occurring on or after the electronic import-export reporting compliance date (§262.84(d)(2)(xv)). Receipt of this signed international movement document serves as a confirmation of receipt of the hazardous waste shipment.
3. You must send a copy of the signed and date confirmation of recovery or disposal, as soon as possible, but no later than 30 days after completing recovery or disposal on the waste in the shipment and no later than one calendar year following receipt of the waste, to the foreign exporter and to the competent authority of the country of export. On or after the electronic import-export reporting compliance date, you must send a copy to EPA electronically at the same time using EPA's WIETS (§262.84(g)(1)).
4. If you cannot manage part or all of the import shipment contents in accordance with the consented management operation listed in the notice, the contract provisions of §262.84(f)(4) apply. You will need to immediately inform the foreign exporter, U.S. importer, and EPA of the need to arrange alternate management or return. The person specified in the contract will then need to assume responsibility for the adequate management of the rejected hazardous wastes from the import shipment in compliance with applicable laws and regulations including, if alternative arrangements cannot be made to recover the hazardous waste in an environmentally sound manner in the United States, arranging for the return of the hazardous wastes and, as the case may be, shall provide the notification for re-export to a third country required in §262.84(b)(6). If the return shipment will cross any transit country, the return shipment may only occur after EPA provides notification to and obtains consent from the competent authority of the country of transit, and provides a copy of that consent to the importer.
5. If you performed any of recovery operations R12, R13, or RC16, or disposal operations D13 through D15, or DC17, you must send copies of the confirmation of recovery or disposal that you receive from the final recovery or disposal facility within one year of shipment delivery to the final recovery or disposal facility that performed one of recovery operations R1 through R11, or RC14 to RC15, or one of disposal operations D1 through D12, or DC15 to DC16, to the competent authority of the country of export. On or after the electronic import-export reporting compliance date, you must send a copy to EPA electronically at the same time using EPA's WIETS (§262.84(g)(2)).
6. You must file a biennial report with your authorized State Agency or regional EPA office (if the State Agency is not authorized to implement the BR program) by March 1 of each even numbered year to report both hazardous wastes generated and hazardous wastes received from off-site during the previous calendar year, including those from a foreign source (§§ 264.75 and 265.75). Reporting on hazardous wastes received from off-site sources is done using the "waste received from off-site (WR)" form, as appropriate. As stated previously, if you are both the importer and the receiving facility, an EPA-acceptable alternative for you to meet your generator biennial reporting requirement for those import shipments would be for you to add a statement to the comment field of your WR form for those import shipments noting that your facility was the importer of record for the listed import shipment(s). Please check with your authorized State Agency on how best to meet your generator biennial reporting requirements. Please also read the importer instructions above.
7. You must keep the following records for at least three years (§§ 262.84(h)(2), 264.71(a)(2)(vi), 264.74, 265.71(a)(2)(vi), and 265.74):
 - a. The original confirmation of receipt (i.e., movement document), a copy of which you previously sent to the foreign exporter;
 - b. A copy of each RCRA manifest;
 - c. A copy of each confirmation of recovery or disposal that you sent to the foreign exporter;
 - d. A copy of each contract;
 - e. A copy of the biennial report; and
 - f. For receiving facilities that performed any interim recovery or disposal operations, a copy of each confirmation of recovery or disposal that the final recovery or disposal facility sent to you.
8. You may satisfy these recordkeeping requirements by retaining electronically submitted documents in your respective accounts on EPA's WIETS or EPA's e-Manifest system, provided that copies are readily available for viewing and production if requested by any EPA or authorized state inspector.
